
#### **Career Opportunity**

#### ST. LAWRENCE HOLY DOOR PILGRIMAGE



Saturday, October 8<sup>th</sup> at 11:30 am, the Holy Door at the Cathedral of the Most Blessed Sacrament in Detroit will be reserved for a pilgrimage specifically for the St. Lawrence Parish and Knights of Columbus Council.

This is a great opportunity for the parish since the Holy Door ends on November 20<sup>th</sup>, and dates in October are fully booked.

Holy Doors have been opened in all the Cathedrals of the world as part of the Jubilee Year of Mercy.

"The Holy Door will become a Door of Mercy through which anyone who comes will experience the love of God who consoles, pardons, and instills hope." – Pope Francis, *Misericordiae Vultus*, *3.* 

Pilgrims will be granted an indulgence (God's remission of temporal punishment for sins already forgiven) for entering the holy door, along with having a recently attended confession, receiving communion, and praying for the pope.

Plan to arrive at 11:30 am at the Cathedral parking lot behind the church, and the self-guided walking tour starts outdoors and 8 stations are in places leading you through the holy door and into the Blessed Sacrament Chapel.
