- May 2 St. Athanasius He fought the Arian heresy most of his life. A giant in the history of our Church. Was forced into exile.
- 2. May 3 St. James the Less The author of the first Catholic Epistle, was the son of Alphaues of Cleophas, his mother Mary was either a sister or a close relative of the Blessed Virgin, and for that reason, according to Jewish custom, he was sometimes called the brother of the Lord. The Apostle held a distinguished position in the early Christian community of Jerusalem. St. Paul tells us he was a witness of the Resurrection of Christ, he is also a "pillar" of the Church, whom St. Paul consulted about the Gospel.
- 3. May 5 St. Hilary A Doctor of the Church.
- 4. May 6 St. Dominic Savio 19th century. Died age 14, while studying for the priesthood. His teacher, St. Don Bosco, wrote a biography of him.
- 5. May 10 St. Damien Worked as a missionary in Hawaii among the lepers, with Sr. Marianne Kope.
- 6. May 13 Mother's Day We honor our mother's for all that they contribute to our families.

- 7. May 14 St. Matthias He was chosen by the Apostles to replace Judas.
- 8. May 30 St. Joan of Arc Died at the hands of the British at age 19. She was canonized in 1930.




